Important Registration Information

We are asking our families to be prompt in returning the Pre-Registration forms sent home on Wednesday for the 2012-2013 school year.

Due to several grades being at maximum capacity it is imperative that pre-registration forms are turned in prior to Open House.

Once Open Enrollment begins on January 29th, registrations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis.

- Tuition Rates will be released mid spring after the Finance Commission meeting.
- PSAS (Private School Aid Service) forms will be sent home by the end of January.
- Registration Fee is \$60 non-refundable for each student.
- We are currently accepting preschool registrations. The registration fee is \$60 per preschooler and costs for our 3 day program (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8 - 11 am) will average around \$150 per month.
