Preschool Tuition Expenses and Requirements for Preschool and TK

Registration fee: \$60.00 per student

Tuition: 3-Day Pre-K tuition is \$1350 (\$150.00 per month)

We do not offer a multi-child discount for the Preschool Program.

***Please note that Early Learning Program students must be toilet-trained and self sufficient in the bathroom.**

Children age 5 by Sept 30, 2012 are eligible for Kindergarten.

Children age 4 by Sept 30, 2012 are eligible for 4 year old Preschool.

Children age 3 by Sept 30, 2012 are eligible for 3 year old Preschool.

Children age 5 by Sept 30, 2012 and are not academically and/or socially ready for Kindergarten are eligible for TK.
