MEETING NOTES:

- 1. Opening Prayer Michael Taylor
- 2. Budget Update Nicole Chapman
 - We had income of just over \$1,200
 - Dave Bogle mentioned that he just received a Box Tops check for just over \$900
- 3. STEM Update Kim Bigelow
 - The new STEM committee is laying out what the plan is going to be for the rest of this year and for next.
 - A Science Olympiad Team was recently formed and had 15 students, which is enough for a
 full team. This includes students from 4th through 8th grades. They are signed up for the big
 competition in March. We are starting small but hoping for even more interest next year.
 We've signed up for one competition this year hoping for further invitations if the team does
 well next year. There are fees involved in further competitions.
 - The STEM committee will be posting a weekly STEM column in the Charger Chatter
 - They are also working with the Library to kickoff January as STEM book season
 - Another individual is planning a STEM family activity; possibly doing a STEM scavenger hunt.
 - 4th and 5th graders had "Mr. C. and His Hair Raising Science" come before Christmas break, and the committee might bring other groups in for grades K-3, such as Boonshoft on Wheels or some other STEM related presenter
 - STEM sent out a survey to the staff about what role they would like to see the STEM
 committee take on, and 13 faculty members responded. Those that responded said they
 would like easily accessible STEM materials and activities with minimal prep-time, and
 resources for classroom activities. The staff also showed interest in the possibility of a STEM
 cart to use in the classroom.
 - The STEM committee should have a mapped out plan for the next year finalized by the end of the month, including costs.
- 4. Fish n' Chips Update Michael Taylor, Liberty Malenich
 - The Fish n' Chips committee need to confirm that Lisa Carlson going to handle the volunteer list again this year. We need to get the volunteer list finalized so we can start the request for volunteers. There are a few more spots that need to be finalized, depending on whether there will be a family tent. Then we will get the list to Lisa and out to families.
 - Volunteers will sign up through an online sign up website. Information on how to sign up will be announced in the Charger Chatter.
 - Please remind parents that this is a great way to get volunteer hours for their family. Volunteers do not need to be VIRTUS trained in order to volunteer for Fish n' Chips.
 - If any committees need room for prep or space please request the space ahead of time. The committee needs to decide when they will need access to the gym, and starting 2:00pm on Thursday the cafeteria will be free. There is no school the Friday of the Fish n' Chips.
 - If the silent auction committee needs space for basket wrapping the school will have to coordinate around others that might need the space, such as scouts, etc.
 - Need PTO reps to stay on top of informing families, keep pushing the day, we will have yard signs available, posters will be available in the office which could be posted at local restaurants or places that get a lot of traffic.

- School Directory Update Dave Bogle: School Directories will be available in the office. If

 phone number. Will look into possibly paying our printer to print a small amount to be
 distributed on a first-come first-served basis.
- Catholic Schools Week update Dave Bogle
 - The Open House will be on Monday, January 29th and the Science Fair will be open in the gym this night for grades 4 through 8.
 - A mailer will go out to non-St. Charles households inviting them to the Open House.
 Existing families generally go to the science fair and come to lunch with their kids, but do not necessarily to come to the open house to visit classrooms and teachers of current students. The intent if for the Open House to be a recruiting effort.
 - Teacher appreciation lunches are on Tuesday January 30th. The PTO will provide the lunch for the teachers. Teachers are asking Virtus trained individuals to cover their classroom so that all 50 staff members can eat lunch together. A link will be coming to volunteer to provide food, help serve, plates, etc. The PTO is purchasing a special gift for all of the teachers. It will be a pullover, ¾ zip, or fleece item that has St. Charles logo and says "STAFF". This is being done in lieu of the gift cards at Christmas.
 - Wednesday that week is the all area school mass at Incarnation this year.
 - Thursday is student appreciation day
 - Friday is St. Charles mass because it is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord.
 - Sometime during the week families will be invited to eat lunch with their child during their designated lunch period. Will be throughout the week.
