Budget Update- Total in Bank 172k – **current balance \$180,365.80**

- Dewey's pizza check has not been cashed; need to contact to determine reason. – **original check has been canceled, and new check has been reissued.**

Old business:

- Final vote on new teacher laptops, Mr. Bogle has quotes that will be presented during meeting – **approved, final quote \$41,330.00, laptops will be ordered prior to winter break.**
- Maggie proposes to allocate funds to security upgrades and Walsh Hall expenses.
 - Walsh Hall Renovation & Security Campaign- Request for Give-Back funds and FNC funds to go towards Charged to Protect Campaign
 - Requests Funds in the same amount previously voted upon for modular classrooms to the Charged to Protect Campaign
FNC and give-back funds will remain with PTO. Funds originally allocated to modular classrooms have been placed back in the unallocated funds portion of the budget.
